

## Board Leadership and Corporate Governance in Emerging Markets

### Content

This course breaks down into three parts. Firstly The Learning Zone which is a set of course notes, case studies and quizzes on the subject of International Corporate Governance. The second is Day 1 of the training course which looks at roles, responsibilities and procedures for directors and thirdly Day 2 of the course where the director looks at how they engage with the board by thinking about their leadership style.

#### Part I (pre-course): The Learning Zone

The Learning Zone module 'Role of the Director and the Board - International' introduces the director and board as being responsible for the organisation's corporate governance. It looks at the role, duties and legal responsibilities of a director, and at the workings of a board. In particular, the course sets the context in which the director and board work, creating a climate that is in/entrepreneurial in nature, where risks are managed within an increasingly regulated environment.

#### Part II (Oct 15): Role and Responsibility

This module introduces the director and board as being responsible for the organisation's corporate governance. It looks at the role, duties and legal responsibilities of a director, and at the workings of a board. In particular, the course sets the context in which the director and board work, creating a climate that is in/entrepreneurial in nature, where risks are managed within an increasingly regulated environment.
